Turtle and Tortoise Papers Presented at the International Congress of Chelonian Conservation

The International Congress of Chelonian Conservation was held at Gonfaron, France, from 6–9 July 1995. Hosted by SOPTOM (Station d'Observation de Protection des Tortues des Maures) and its Director, Bernard Devaux, the Congress brought together approximately 250 turtle and tortoise specialists from about 35 nations. Third World Congress on Herpetology – Preliminary Announcement



THIRD WORLD CONGRESS
ON HERPETOLOGY
PRAGUE, 2-10 August 1997





The Third World Congress on Herpetology will be held in Prague, Czech Republic, 2–10 August, 1997. It will cover all topics in herpetology, including paleoherpetology. The scientific program will be divided into two parts by one day of professional excursions that will include also areas that served for the past 50 years as military exercise fields closed to public, with populations of amphibians and reptiles developed within this period of time in natural conditions not affected by anthropogenic activities. It is expected that there will be some accompanying events like exhibition in the National Museum "Origin and Evolution of European Herpetofauna" where both fossil and contemporary amphibians and reptiles will be presented, on the background of
